

Agencies required to report under the Queensland Government Regulator Performance Framework

The following organisations are required to prepare and publish annual regulator performance reports under the Framework.

Where there are multiple regulators within a department, reporting can be presented at the level of the individual regulatory units or presented in relation to the main areas of legislation/regulation administered. In these cases, the appropriate level of aggregation of reporting is at the discretion of the relevant department.
