

Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required	<p>The proposal relates to consequential amendments to the <i>Explosives Regulation 2017</i> as a result of amendments to the <i>Explosives Act 1999</i>. No regulatory impact analysis is required under the Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy.</p> <p><u>Sale of small arms ammunition</u></p> <p>The <i>Queensland Community Safety Act 2024</i> made amendments to the <i>Explosives Act 1999</i> to stipulate a requirement for a vendor to verify a person's licence or authority, prior to purchasing small arms ammunition. The <i>Explosives Act 1999</i> stipulates that the verification system will be prescribed by regulation. The <i>Explosives Amendment Regulation 2026</i> prescribes the verification systems available for use.</p>
