



Proposal type	Details
Regulatory proposals where no regulatory impact analysis is required	This proposal is to omit section 96 of the <i>Petroleum and Gas (Safety) Regulation 2018</i> as the compliance plate and related matters for gas system installation for section 734(3) of the <i>Petroleum and Gas (Production and Safety) Act 2004</i> will no longer be prescribed and instead will be included in the functionality of a new online system. The proposal is deregulatory and does not increase costs or regulatory burden on business. While the proposal does retain existing regulation it does reduce the costs associated with meeting those requirements.
