Minor and machinery in nature - Proclamation	The proposal is machinery in nature, to make a proclamation to fix the day for the commencement of an Act and does not substantively change regulatory policy or introduce new impacts on business, government, or the community. The Proclamation will fix 12 March 2026 as the commencement date of the remaining provisions in the <i>Energy Roadmap Amendment Act 2025</i> that did not commence on assent. These remaining provisions relate to the Act's Priority Transmission Investment framework and were the subject of a prior impact analysis statement. No further regulatory impact analysis is required.
