

Minor and machinery in nature	<p>The Proclamation will commence the <i>Queensland Institute of Medical Research Act 2025</i> (Act) on 1 December 2025.</p> <p>The Act repeals and replaces the <i>Queensland Institute of Medical Research Act 1945</i>, establishing a modern legislative framework to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">strengthen governance arrangements for the Queensland Institute of Medical Research (Institute);enhance transparency and accountability; andsupport the Institute’s continued role as a leading medical research organisation in Queensland and internationally. <p>Queensland Health has assessed the Proclamation as minor and machinery in nature, as it merely commences legislation that has already been passed but is not yet in operation. In line with the <i>Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy</i>, Queensland Health has determined that the Proclamation does not introduce new regulatory impacts and, given its machinery nature, does not require a regulatory impact analysis.</p>
