Regulatory proposals where no RIA is required	This proposal amends the <i>Disability Services Regulation 2017</i> by: - transitioning fees relating to National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) clearances (pursuant to section 68 and 103 of the <i>Disability Services Act 2006</i>) back to the fee unit model in line with the Queensland Government <i>Principles for Fees and Charges</i>, following the ending on 30 June 2026 of a temporary exemption which applied a fee amount model to these fees; and - increasing the fee amounts relating to NDIS clearances from \$156.00 to 142.37 fee units (equivalent to \$161.30). This proposal relates to standard fee variations, in line with, or below a government indexation factor and is not subject to RIA requirements under the <i>Queensland Government Better Regulation Policy</i>.
